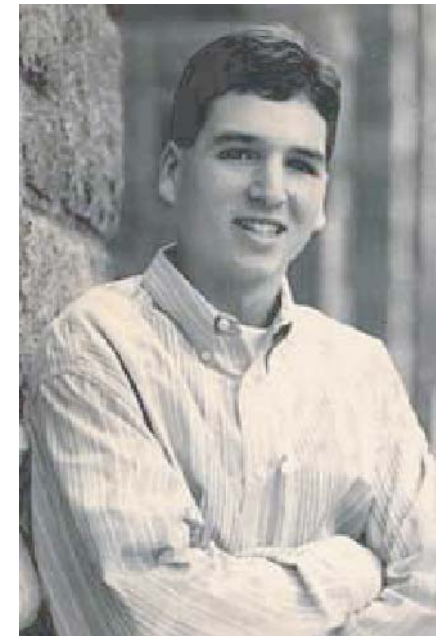

Our mission is to share PJ's story with high school seniors before they graduate to encourage them to think twice as they face choices that at the time may not seem important but might change not only their lives but also the lives of the people who love them.

My family and I have visited many high schools on the South Shore of Massachusetts. We meet with students and we tell our story and try to reach as many kids as possible.
