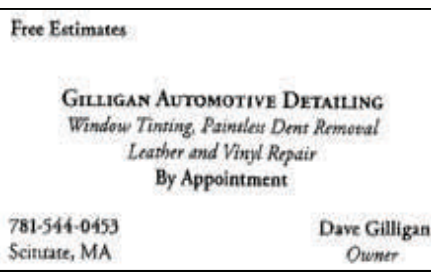
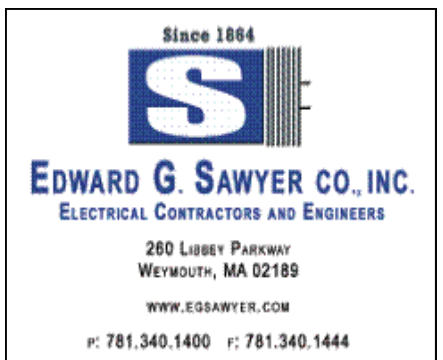
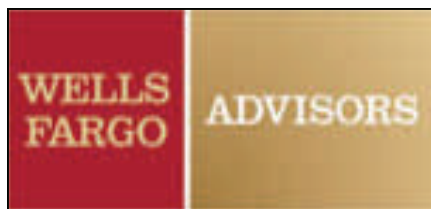

P.J. Steverman Golf Classic - Support of CORSE

The Scituate CORSE Foundation raises funds to provide the highest quality educational and recreational community experiences so students with special needs can reach their full potential. The Foundation allocates funds for a wide range of supplemental resources that will benefit students, parents and educators within our community such as after-school programs, recreational activities, technology and training which have a profound impact on those whose needs are greatest.

CORSE has been blessed to have the opportunity to collaborate with the Scituate Recreation Department to bring a variety of high impact recreational opportunities to children with special needs in our community. Every member of the Recreation Department, Recreation Commission and the Friends of Scituate Recreation have been so very supportive to make this customized programming a reality for our children with the greatest needs. In reality, these programs are very expensive to run given the specialized staffing required: the coaches all have special education backgrounds, and we run programs at a 3:1 student to staff ratio to assure safety and high quality skill development. What has been instrumental in the ability for us to provide these customized programs at an affordable rate to our Scituate families has been the continued support of the Friends, primarily through the PJ Steverman Tournament. Each year, proceeds from this fundraiser are provided to CORSE to continue to provide our high level of programming for children with special needs. In fact, an extremely generous compilation of donations totaling \$5,000 was provided to us from a special live CORSE funds request at the tournament dinner. Words cannot express how appreciative we are of this support and generosity from the Steverman family and the community. The following is a brief outline of how the funds are used:
